To find out whether there are any vacancies in a given course click the “>” next to the course you are interested in.

For example, if I click the arrow next to course “Monthly Music on Mondays” I get the following display in which I have circled in red the availability information. In this example you can see that this course is still accepting enrolments as there are 20 places and only 14 of them have been filled.

Description
 A lively interactive evening program operates like a book group meeting in members homes. A different member of the group volunteers to put together a program each month. Programs are compiled from YouTube clips DVDS or CDs based around a theme a performer or a music genre reflecting the interests of members. They have mostly been focused on classical music but opera jazz movie themes and various types of folk and world music are frequently included. Wine and snacks are served when we are meeting in homes and are provided by the host. If a host has limited space or needs technical support other members help out. The first 2023 program will be on Monday the 6th March. The program provides the opportunity to learn about new musical genres from each other. All that's required is a love of music. The group may choose to pause during June, July and August since many participants may be unavailable during the winter months.
